## LET'S MAKE A WATERCOLOR MASTERPIECE!

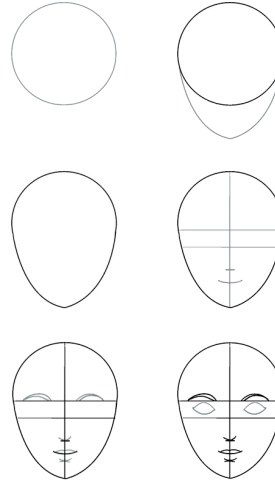
Get ready by finding...

**WATERCOLOR PAINT, PAINT BRUSHES, WATERCOLOR PAPER.** Tip: Tape down your paper to keep it steady.

**01 Find a picture of someone.**

**02 As you paint —**  
Try to notice as many details as you can about that person, and add those details to your painting.

**03 Use different colors**  
Make it yours!



Tip: Try using this guide to sketch their face in pencil before you paint.
