
What are some of the dimensions of you?

Brainstorm.

Before assembling your globe lantern, on a seperate sheet of paper, brainstorm a response to the prompt "What are some of the dimensions of you?".

Time to write.

Now that you have written down some dimensions of you, write your response on 8 of your paper strips, leaving 2 blank.

Full of Love to Spread



Arrange your strips.

Before you begin assembling your globe, remember to have all of your words facing outward. If they are on the inside of the globe, they will be harder to see!

Stack + Fasten.

Stack all of your strips and insert paper fastener through one end and fasten.





Attach the Cup.

On the other end, put your paper fastener through the paper holes and cup, then fasten.

Form a globe.

Spread out the strips to form a alobe.

Attach the string.

Tie string to the fastener on the top for a handle.
